- (2) In these six verses, what ways do you see God's Word to Adam and Eve being subverted?
- (3) Of the six ways to undermine the Word of God that were detailed in the sermon, which do you think is the most subtle? How come?
 - (a) The most dangerous? How come?
 - (b) Are there other ways to undermine the Word that are not seen in these six verses? What are they, and can you think of biblical warnings or examples of them?
- (4) Review the six ways to uphold the Word of God that were detailed in the sermon.
 - (a) Which of these do you think is most important? How come?
 - (b) Most difficult? How come?
 - (c) Are there other ways to uphold the Word that were not mentioned? What are they, and can you think of biblical exhortations or examples to support them?
- (5) Where do you personally struggle in undermining or upholding God's Word? How can you grow in Christ-likeness in that area?
- (6) Where do you personally see Sylvania struggling or succeeding in these things? How, specifically, can we grow?
